## Activity 2 - Money Bingo!

Playing Money Bingo is a great way for you to practice money counting skills.

**Activity Instructions:** Print out cards so that each player has a Bingo card and value cards. Each player fills the boxes by using the coin rubbing method. A host then writes down the monetary amounts on paper for the caller to read aloud. You can place limits on the amounts (\$0.01 to \$1.00) or provide players with a list of amounts to choose from. The caller mixes up the papers and calls the amounts. Players check their cards for the coins that represent that amount. Boxes can be marked using scrap pieces of paper or coins. Once a player has covered four boxes in a row or the four corners, that player wins. Switch cards with another player and start a new game. This time try filling in the entire card.

Card and Calling Card Examples:



25¢	40¢
10¢	31¢
5¢	50¢
70¢	\$1.00
