

# Animal Math

## Activity 5 - Lions Race to 100

Survival can be very difficult for any wild animal, and lions are no exception! In this game, you will understand the competition a lion may face when trying to reach its dinner! 100 feet away from Lion #1 and Lion #2 is some food. Only one lion can take the food back to its family so the race is on to capture the feast!



### Activity Instructions:

This game is for 2 players. Each player has their own board. Decide who will go first.

- Lion #1 rolls the dice and puts that many pieces on the ones column of their board
- After putting the ones on the board, Lion #1 needs to look and see if they can turn in any ones for a ten. If they can trade, do it now.
- Lion #2 takes their turn and completes the same steps as Lion #1.
- The first Lion to reach **exactly 100** wins the game

Hundreds	Tens	Ones

*Note: This game can be adapted by changing the winning number to a lower or higher number.*
