- After 20 minutes of inactivity, you will automatically be logged out of your application. Please be advised that your changes will not be saved.

You will be assigned an OUAC Reference Number once you submit your application. This number is application-specific and is not valid for any other current year or future application services.

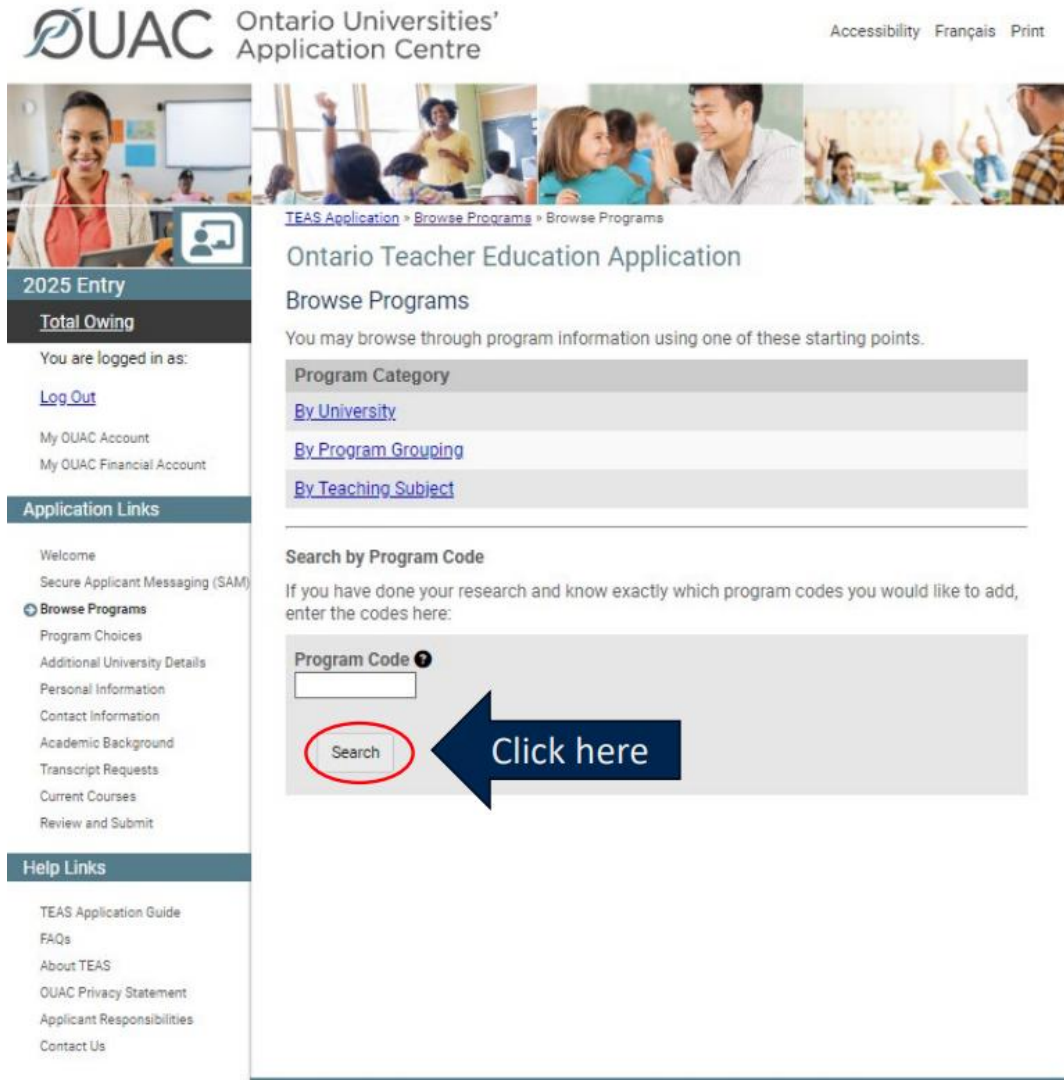

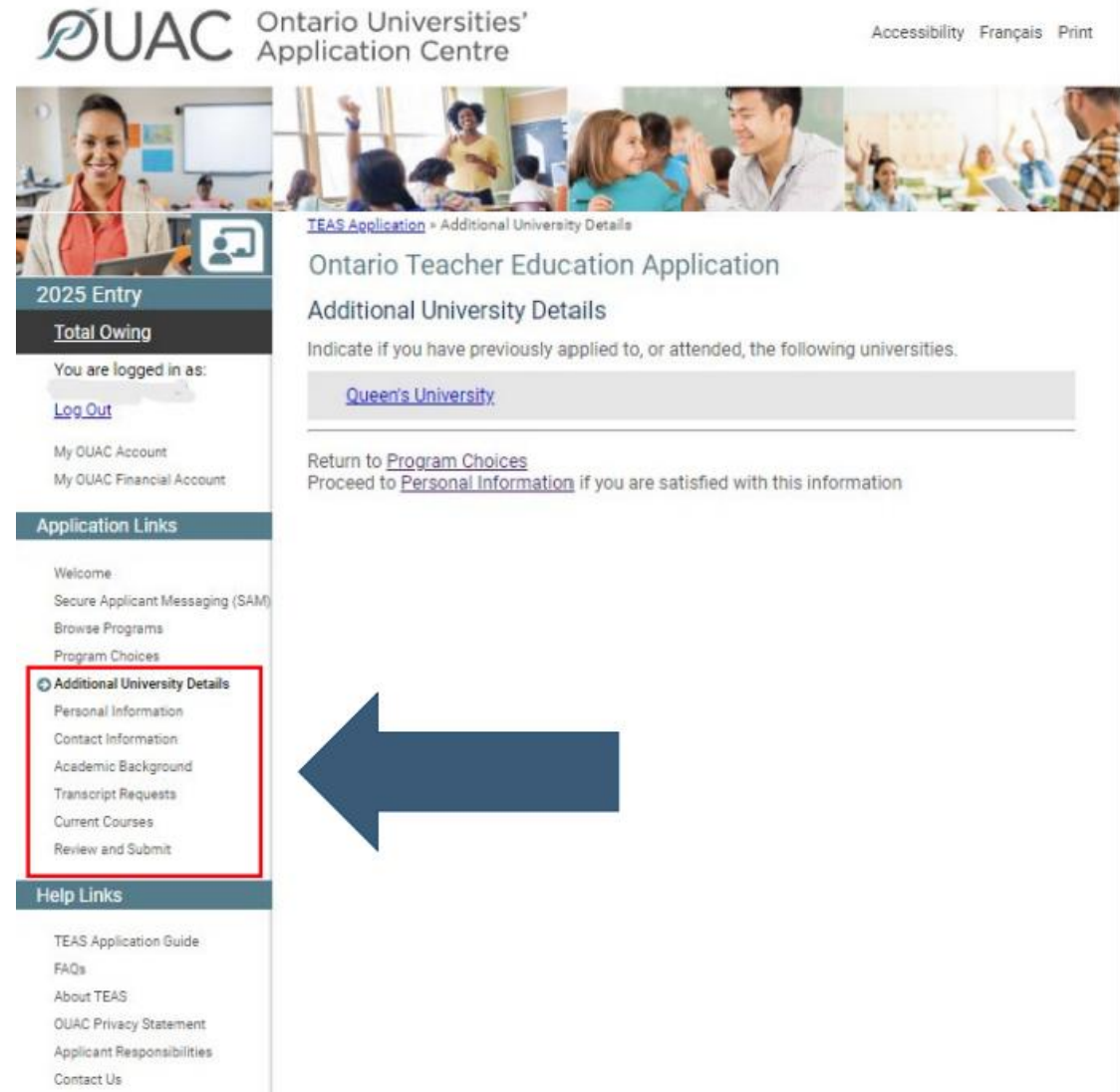

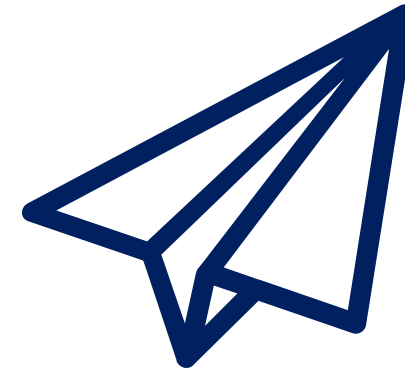

Once you've completed the application, do not pay fees YET

There are two application fees: (1) the Queen's Supplementary Fee & (2) the OUAC/TEAS application fee

STEP ONE

- Email educstudentservices@queensu.ca and provide your OUAC/TEAS application number.
- Queen's University will waive your Queen's Supplementary fee (\$85).
- Wait for confirmation from Queen's that your fee has been waived.



The OUAC/TEAS fee & submitting Part 1

STEP TWO

- Check with your community contact to see whether an OUAC voucher is available. If it is, enter the voucher code provided to cover the cost of the OUAC/TEAS application fee. If a voucher is not available, the cost of the OUAC/TEAS application fee is the responsibility of the applicant.

 - Then you'll complete **Part 2** of the application.

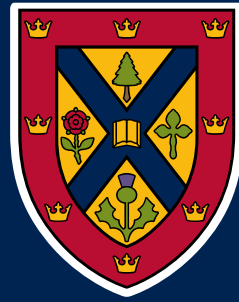
Supplemental Document	Method of Submission
Reference letters from two respected members of your Indigenous community (e.g., Elders, Community Leaders, Work Supervisors, Social/School Counsellors, Educators, Director of local Friendship Centres*). The referees must be able to comment on Indigenous community contributions which you have made, and your potential to serve in the field of Indigenous education. *Reference letters cannot be written by relatives or friends of the applicant	Letters of reference should be submitted by the referees directly to: Student Services Office
Statement of Indigenous Experience (SIE). Please consider your future in Indigenous education when you are completing the SIE. Personal qualities and experiences are vitally important to the successful educator. The Faculty of Education encourages applicants to focus their SIE on what would make you a good teacher. When listing an extracurricular activity or employment opportunity, describe the impact of this experience and the greatest learning outcome for you from the perspective of how that would make you a good teacher. The readers of your SIE will be looking for you to explain how your experiences will help you as a future educator.	Submit SIE via this form
High school transcript showing completion of Ontario Secondary School Diploma. <i>Ontario Secondary School Diploma (Grade 12 Diploma) or GED must be completed by December 1, 2025.</i>	Submit PDF to Supplemental Documents Form
A résumé providing a clear and concise overview of both (a) your academic background, and (b) work experience.	Submit PDF to Supplemental Documents Form

November 10*	Deadline for receipt of official transcripts and supplemental documents. For policies on transcripts, see TEAS Requirements for Queen's.	MyQueens Portal/SOLUS
Late January	Queen's sends first round of offers of admission.	TEAS
February 15*	Deadline to accept Queen's offers of admission through TEAS	TEAS
June 30	Deadline for applicants with conditional offers to submit final transcripts indicating completion or required and/or recommended courses and/or degree conferral.	Submit to: Student Services Office

*IMPORTANT: The deadlines for application, official transcripts, and supplemental document submission are firm, due to the Queen's program starting in May.
