Name and count the shapes you used to make your creature.</p>			
<p>Sort your toys. What's your sorting rule? Colour? Shape? Size?</p>	<p>Go on a shape hunt! Can you find cubes, cones, spheres (such as a ball), prisms (such as a box), pyramids, and cylinders?</p> 	<p>Clap your hands and stomp your feet to make a sound pattern. <i>Clap, Clap, Stomp, Stomp</i> What other patterns can you act out? <i>Stand, Sit, Sit, Stand</i> <i>Turn, Turn, Jump, Jump, Jump</i></p>	<p>Use objects to practice counting by 2s.</p>  <p>What other ways can you count? 5s?, 10s?</p>
